HANCOCK SHAKER VILLAGE CELEBRATES THE 250TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE SHAKERS' ARRIVAL IN AMERICA!

To honor the 250th anniversary of the Shakers' arrival in America, Hancock Shaker Village celebrates the many contributions of leader Ann Lee and her followers. Exhibits throughout the Village honor not only Mother Ann and the Shaker Sisters who lived at Hancock but also the many women who have brought the Shaker story to life since Hancock's inception as a museum in 1961.

Historical narratives are presented through images, writings, recordings, drawings, samplers, correspondences, music, and objects used and made in the Shakers' day-to-day lives. Contemporary reflections on the contributions of the Shaker Sisters are featured in the work of women artists who are influenced and inspired by Shaker women.
